

HVPOA MEMBERS MEETING, April 18th, 2015

---Board Members in attendance: Roy Walker, Brian Cook, Bennie Lee, Don Biery

---Meeting called to order at 10:05 by Roy Walker at the Fairview Senior Center.

---A member asked who the gentleman sitting at the Board of Trustees' table was. He stood and said he was an attorney, Ted McBride representing the Board of Trustees regarding some issues with the recent vote for new Board of Trustees.
